Using the Internet: Levels Foundation – 2

The internet is a vast network which links computers at many sites throughout the world. Using the Internet allows us to communicate with people across the world, using electronic mail and to access vast amounts of information that has educational value. At Chelsea Heights P.S. we have Internet connections in classrooms, the library and the staffroom. Access to the Internet by students will be supervised by teachers and will be for educational purposes only. The purpose of these guidelines is to ensure that students who use the Internet do so in an appropriate manner.

1. Students will follow the teacher's instructions regarding the use of the internet.
2. Students will take care of the computer equipment that they are using.
3. Students will behave in a mature responsible manner when using the Internet.
4. Students will work cooperatively and conscientiously on the Internet.
5. When using the Internet, students will only access appropriate information which is relevant to their work. They will make no attempts to access inappropriate material.
6. Written consent will be obtained from parents and guardians before any child's photographic work or video footage is displayed on the Internet.
7. Students will only use first names on Internet sites and E-mail communications. (They will be taught the importance of not including surnames and addresses or giving out personal details.) Students will respect the privacy of teachers and fellow students by not giving out their personal details or reading their E-mail.
8. Teachers will ensure that any E-mails students send do not contain material that could be considered inappropriate. Students will ensure all E-mails are approved by a teacher before being sent.
9. Students must remember that it is a privilege, not a right, to use the Internet.
